ST. LOUIS SKATING CLUB Professional Coaching Requirements

All professionals wishing to teach on Club ice must meet the following requirements:

- Be a member of and maintain membership in the St. Louis Skating Club;
- Be a member of and maintain membership in the USFS;
- Be a member of and maintain membership in the PSA;
- Maintain liability insurance with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence (and provide the Club with an endorsement naming the Club as an additional insured);
- Agree to abide by all rules, regulations and professional codes of the St. Louis Skating Club, the USFS and the PSA;
- Promote all disciplines of figure skating;
- Actively encourage students to participate in the annual Gateway Invitational;
- Be approved to teach on Club Ice by the St. Louis Skating Club Board of Directors.

** ANY 2010/2011 SLSC approved coach who has not participated in any SLSC activities (i.e. Club Ice, Gateway, Test Sessions, etc) during the past year will need to formally re-apply for the 2011/2012 season. This will include submitting a written request to the SLSC Board of Directors for approval, submitting a resume, and going through the interview process.
